It is intended to encourage and assist veterans in pursuing post-secondary education and training. It is the only Federal education program specifically created to serve the needs of veterans.

VUB provides personalized assistance to help veterans improve academic skills, explore college and training programs, and enjoy a smoother transition from their military service into whatever comes next.

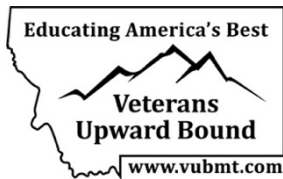

Veterans Upward Bound is a federally funded TRIO program through the Department of Education and is administered by Montana State University Northern.

College Transition Assistance:

These services are provided on an individual basis. Instruction and assistance are provided in the steps necessary to enroll in college.

- College application assistance
- Advocacy with academic history
- Advocacy for accommodation due to disability
- Assistance with GI Bill education benefits
- Assistance applying for federal financial aid
- Degree and career exploration
- Academic advising
- Introduction to online college learning platforms (Moodle, Canvas)
- Referral to campus support: Student Support Services, New Student Services, AcademicSupport Center, Disability Support Services, School Certifying Official & Veterans' Services Office

- Career Assessment Inventory

Online Self-paced Instruction with Faculty/Tutoring Support:

VUB uses an online system called EdReady Montana to provide a broad range of rigorous and engaging self-paced online courses. Content can be customized to meet individual needs. All online courses include tech support and faculty attached to monitor progress and tutor as needed.

Computer Laptop Program:

VUB provides a wide range of online classes to support veterans across Montana. Through our live-online classes, we've expanded access to educational assistance-making it easier than ever for participants to:

- Access real-time support when questions or challenges arise
